1 Learning Objectives

4 Teaching Tip

Model **커요** aloud first. Ask learners to repeat the word, point to the English meaning, then write it once without looking.

5 Extension Activity

Have learners create a two-line mini dialogue using **커요** and **작아요**. For extra speaking practice, one student asks the question and another answers using the target vocabulary.

Assessment idea: Learner can read, match, and write at least six target words without help.
