Sound / Use: 예절 means or represents etiquette. Romanization: yejeol.

Teacher note: Culture words depend on speaker, age, relationship, and situation. Practice the context, not only the translation.

Study order: Read aloud, trace slowly, write independently, then check spacing and sound.

2. Decide when the word is appropriate.
3. Write one English note and one Korean example.
