1 Learning Objectives

- Learn 8 beginner Korean words or phrases.
- Read Korean with romanization as temporary support.
- Write key Korean words by hand.
- Use the target language in a short beginner conversation.

4 Teaching Tip

Model 약국 aloud first. Ask learners to repeat the word, point to the English meaning, then write it once without looking.

5 Extension Activity

Have learners create a two-line mini dialogue using 약국 and 약. For extra speaking practice, one student asks the question and another answers using the target vocabulary.

Assessment idea: Learner can read, match, and write at least six target words without help.
