

Korean Topic Marker 은/는 Worksheet

Beginner Grammar

Choose the topic marker and write simple sentences



Sound / Use: Use 은 after a final consonant and 는 after a vowel. The marker shows the sentence topic.

Teacher note: 은/는 is not simply the English word is. It marks what the sentence is mainly about.

Study order: Read aloud, trace slowly, write independently, then check spacing and sound.

1. Stroke or Pattern Steps

1. Look at the final sound of the noun.
2. Choose 은 if the noun ends in a consonant.
3. Choose 는 if the noun ends in a vowel.
